

## **Important questions concerning JesusChurch's services moving to The Chapel**

### **1. Where and when will JesusChurch meet on Sundays starting in March, 2021?**

Location: The Chapel at Fishhawk, 6026 Churchside Dr, Lithia FL, 33547

Time: 11:15am

### **2. Why is our service time changing to 11:15am isn't that kinda late?**

- In general, it is a blessing for JesusChurch to have the ability to meet on Sunday mornings at The Chapel.
- The Chapel and JesusChurch both were meeting at 10am on Sundays. After much prayer and discernment, The Chapel decided to meet between 9:30am and 10:30am. JesusChurch decided to meet at 11:15am to allow some time between the services for transitional purposes.

### **3. Why are we not staying at the Regent?**

- God has been calling us to do more ministry both on Sundays and during the week for a long time. By meeting at The Chapel, JesusChurch will be able to step into that calling in a much greater way.
- We are looking forward to not having to rush out of our services on Sundays, allowing us more time for prayer, ministry and fellowship.
- We will more easily be able to use the grounds for outreaches, VBS, cookouts and host community events.
- At The Chapel the equipment will stay set up, thus eliminating set up and tear down, wear and tear on the equipment and volunteer burnout.

#### **4. Why are we specifically moving to The Chapel? Why not somewhere closer?**

- In short, God has prepared this specific path for us. We have considered many other options with the board, the staff and community leaders over the past six months. Please watch our January 31st, Sunday service where we go over the details of how God brought this plan together.

#### **5. Why now?**

- This has been a God led process where He has directed us at every step and in His timing. Nothing has happened by chance. There have been many miracles along the way. The Pastors, Board and Staff are all agreed that this is a move of God. We are genuinely awed by His provision and direction guiding us through this season “for such a time as this.”

#### **6. How long are we staying there?**

- Until God tells us to move somewhere else, we are planning to stay at The Chapel for the foreseeable future.

#### **7. Is JesusChurch merging or combining with The Chapel?**

- We are not merging nor are we combining, with the exception of our youth programs. The youth are combining on Wednesday nights 6:30-8:15pm and Nathan will work alongside their leadership team.

- JesusChurch is sharing the building with The Chapel. Both churches have their own Sunday service time slot as well as blocked off time during the week to use the building.

**8. Are we welcome to attend any of “The Chapel’s” services and vice versa?**

- Absolutely, we are encouraging each others’ congregations to “be the church.” Although we are two separate churches, sharing one building, we are both a part of the Kingdom of God. We would be honored if some of The Chapel’s congregation worshipped with us during JesusChurch’s service and the opposite is true as well.
- There will be an open door policy for support groups such as Financial Peace, University, Grief Share and Men’s Fight Club.

**9. Is JesusChurch officially renting The Chapel’s space?**

- Yes, we have a lease with The Chapel.

**10. What about a building/G3? Why not our own space?**

- The “Gather Grow Go” campaign is not stopping.
- Our “Next Step Facility Funds” are still intact and growing.
- The board and the staff considered many options such as purchasing an existing church building, leasing a store front or warehouse space and even considered building something from scratch. We became educated about those different avenues and we prayed for God’s direction. The final decision was made that sharing space with The Chapel is the best next step for JesusChurch.
